Our Membership Dues and Categories

Commercial Service Airports:

- Airports with greater than 100,000 annual enplanements (includes up to 5 contacts; additional contacts will be at Associate dues rate). **Dues \$1500**
- Airports with less than 100,000 annual enplanements (includes up to 3 contacts; additional contacts will be at the Associate dues rate). **Dues \$1000**

General Aviation Airports:

- Airports with greater than 50,000 annual operations (includes up to 2 contacts; additional contacts will be at the Associate dues rate.) **Dues \$500**
- Airports with less than 50,000 annual operations (includes up to 2 contacts; additional contacts will be at the Associate dues rate.) **Dues \$300**

Corporate Members:

- Open to public and private corporations and companies involved in the aviation industry and wish to participate in GAA activities and further their contacts with airport professionals. **Dues \$600**

Associate Members:

- Open to individuals who wish to be closely identified with aviation, including airport employees, board members, etc. that is above the Airport Membership allotment, also includes pilots, flying clubs, etc. **Dues \$125**

Educational:

- Open to any accredited college or university, trade or technical school with a curriculum devoted to aviation education. **Dues \$125**

Student:

- Open to individuals actively engaged and currently enrolled in full time study of aviation related fields at an accredited college or university, or technical school. **Dues \$30**

Private Airports - \$75
